

# Important Safety Recall

## Dear Campbell Hausfeld Customer:

Thank you for purchasing a Campbell Hausfeld air compressor. We want to be sure you are aware of a recent situation involving some air compressor models.

In cooperation with the Consumer Product Safety Commission, Campbell Hausfeld is conducting a voluntary recall of certain HL and HX model number air compressors. We determined that the plastic motor cover material may not meet proper flame retardant requirements and has the potential for being a fire hazard.

Because customer safety is our highest priority, we ask that you please stop using your compressor immediately until it is verified that it is not part of the recall. If your air compressor is included, Campbell Hausfeld will issue you a replacement shroud kit that comes with installation instructions.

- This recall is confined to the use of motor covers on specific Campbell Hausfeld and Husky brand air compressors.
- The compressors included in this recall were sold between September 2005 and the present time with the following date codes for the HL4XXX and HX4XXX series:: Two letter prefix KB, HU or HY followed by two digit month and two digit year with the date range 0705 through 0307. For the HL5402 series it is the first four digits of the serial number with the date range 1106 through 1107.

If your Compressor has a "V" mark or symbol on the plastic motor shroud or packaging then it already has the correct replacement part and is NOT part of our recall.

To determine if your compressor is included in the recall you will first need your model and serial numbers from the decal(s) on your compressor.

If you can not locate your model/serial number or they are unreadable, please call our Recall Hotline.
